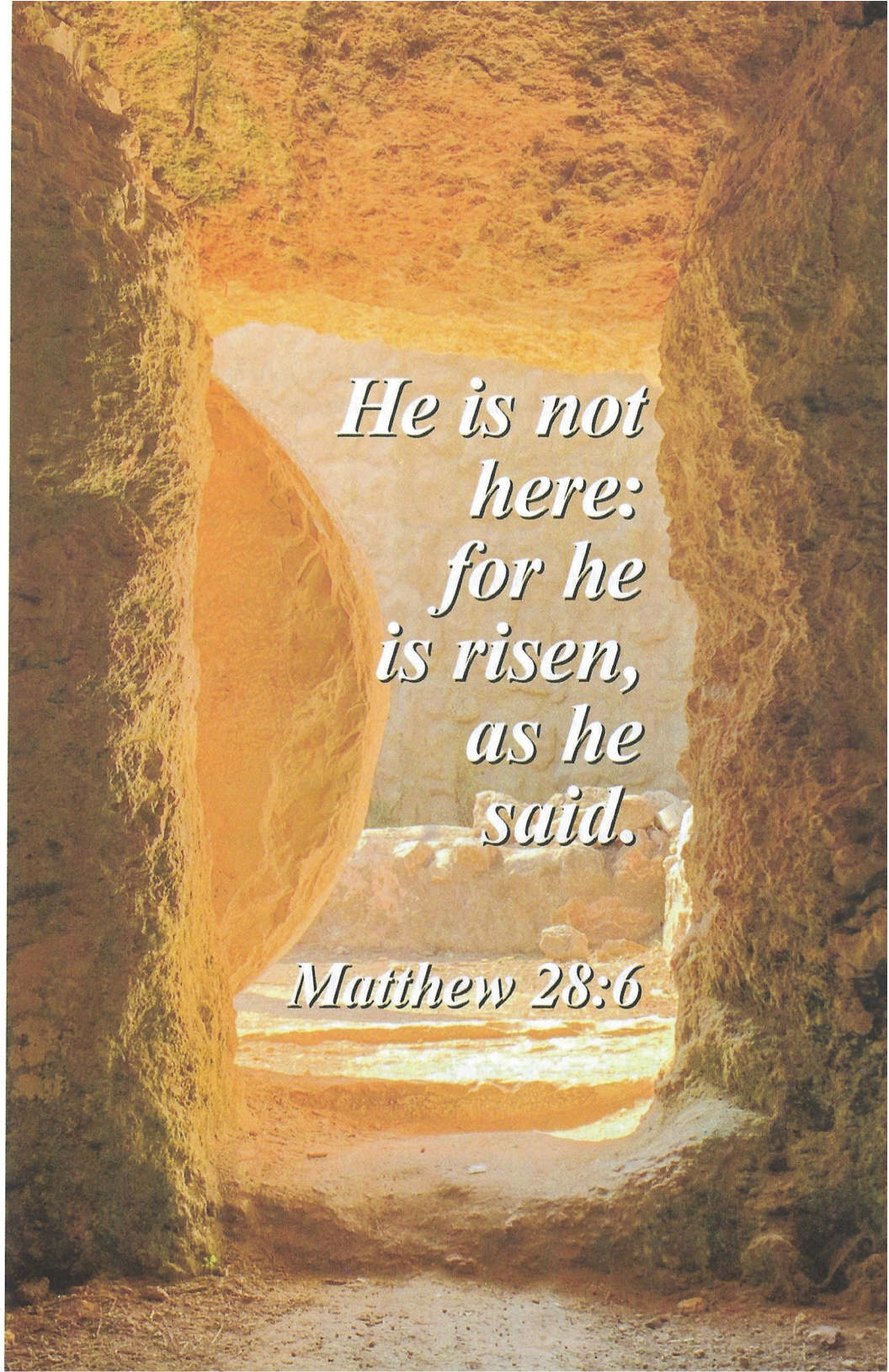

“A Breach of Security”

Matthew 27:62-28:15

Summary: Our response to the crucifixion and resurrection reveals where we find our security. True safety is only found by surrendering in faith to the crucified and risen Jesus.
