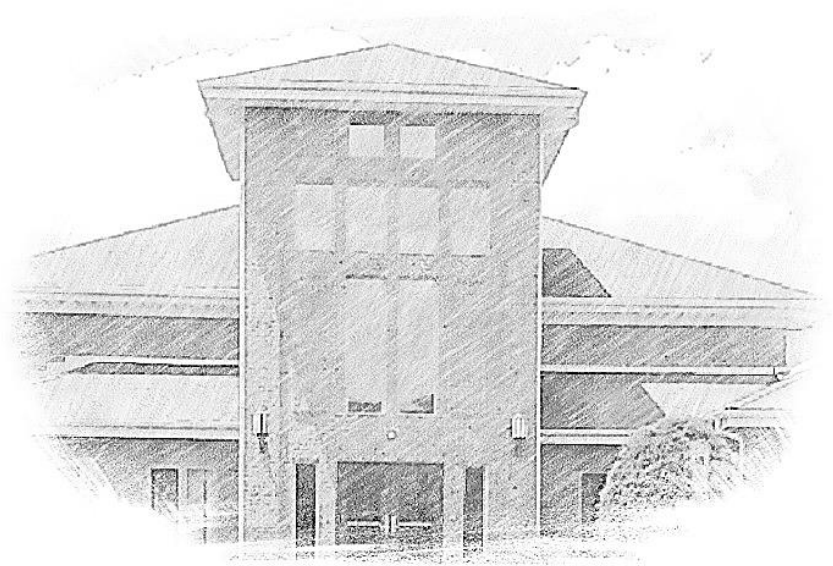

1 Corinthians 6:12-20

Summary: The world (and often the church) sets the goal of sexuality far too low. Far from being ashamed of the topic, Christians should celebrate the better story of sex that leads us to God.
