Psalm 18:1-19

Summary: For all the beautiful flowery language, the main theme of the Psalms (and the Bible) is that we are in a whole mess of trouble, and God powerfully rescues us from it.

- The Lord to Whom We Turn (v.1-3)

- The Plight We Face (v.4-5)

- The Rescue He Provides (v.6-15)

- The Victory We Possess (v.16-19)
